

Boil Water Notice – 09/28/2026

PUBLIC NOTICE TO BOIL WATER

For the following Roads in the Jackson Well Area:

VZCR 2410, 2404, 2405, 2413, 2409, 2437, 3227, and FM 1651

Any customer in the area above who experiences low or no pressure during the emergency line repair.

Due to reduced pressure in the distribution system during water leak repairs at FM 1651, the area listed above experienced a pressure drop below 20 pounds PSI. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system, MacBee Special Utility District, PWS I.D. # 2340045, to notify customers to boil their water before consumption (e.g., washing hands or face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc.). Children, seniors, and individuals with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria; therefore, all customers should follow these directions.

To ensure the destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and then cooled before use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil, then boiled for 2 minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from a suitable alternative source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption.

Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
