

Boil Water Notice – (2-16-2024)

PUBLIC NOTICE TO BOIL WATER

The intersection of FM 47 and VZ County Road 2602

VZ County Road 2147, North of VZ County Road 2110

And VZ County Road 2148

*****The crew is currently working on a water main break in this area. If you experience low pressure or no water this evening, this boil water notice will affect you.*****

Due to a reduced distribution system pressure at the addresses above (add reason ex: dropping Below 20 pounds PSI,) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system, MacBee Special Utility District, PWS I.D. # 2340012 to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc). Children, seniors, and persons with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria, and all customers should follow these directions.

To ensure the destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption.

Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
