Boil Water Notice – 8-16-2025

PUBLIC NOTICE TO BOIL WATER For the following:

GARDEN CITY AREA PARTS OF VZCR 3910, PARTS OF VZCR 3908, PARTS OF THE NORTH SIDE OF I-20 SERVICE ROAD

ALL OF VZCR 3919 AND PRIVATE ROAD 7910

*** Any MacBee customer who experiences no water during the emergency main repair in the Garden City area, please follow the boil water notice below. ***

Due to reduced distribution system pressure in the area above. The pressure dropping below 20 pounds PSI, the **Texas Commission on Environmental Quality** (TCEQ) has required our water system, MacBee Special Utility District, PWS I.D. # 2340012, to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc.). Children, seniors, and individuals with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria; therefore, all customers should follow these directions.

To ensure the destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and then cooled before use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from a suitable alternative source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption.

Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
